Oil Recycling Sheds

The waste oil recycling sheds have returned. They are in different locations now: one shed is in the courtyard at D-Dock and the other is in the Launch Ramp Parking lot. *As always, please do not leave oil or filters outside! Please call the Harbor Office for access. Containers left outside can spill which pretty much defeats the purpose of the recycling.*

Part of the reason the sheds are in new locations is to cut down on illegal dumping; and in the E-Dock parking lot it appears that the shed was providing some cover for some unsavory activity. So, at the City's request we did not return the shed to Melville Square (ie E-Dock).

Registration & Documentation Renewal

It's that time of year again! Don't forget to update your registration and place the new sticker on your boat! Richmond PD and/or Contra Costa County Sheriff can and will cite vessels in the marina for expired registration — even in their slips!

If you have a documented vessel, you're not off the hook either. It's pretty easy to look up the expiration date of a documented vessel and if it is expired it is subject to DMV requirements and can be ticketed! Make sure you provide the Harbor Office with a copy of your updated documentation.

Every year we get complaints about this, but it shouldn't be a surprise since it happens every year. So please, make sure you get your registration updated in a timely fashion to avoid getting a ticket!

Ongoing Marina Promotions

Referral Program — refer a new permanent tenant and get one month's berth rent once they have stayed six months! Make sure your referral indicates you on their application.

Pay in Advance — get a 3% discount if you pay 6-months in advance and a 10% discount if you pay a full year in advance.
